

Dear Hali,

I am contacting you in the interest of transparency and due to the fact that you handle ‘women’s issues’ in ICD. Please find attached my most recent correspondence in the past decade to ‘public authorities’; this time to [Prince Charles](#). In my report to him “State of the Union during the Demise of Democracy” I explain how not only the IMF (and World Bank and UN) are the motor behind increasingly unstable economies (and societies), but also how they are responsible for the escalation in extremism, violence, terrorism, and break down in the rule of law in countries around the world, by their omission of action. Not only is this in direct contradiction to their mandates, but it is costing taxpayers \$9 billion usd each year, on top of another \$1 billion going to their ‘partners in crime’, NGOs and think tanks in ‘The Swamp’, with corporate taxpayers and shareholders footing the bill for their empty rhetoric. **Instead of preventing another World War and demise of the planet, these organizations are assuring our demise, and descent into Purgatory.**

Donald Trump won his bid for presidency with a promise to “drain the Swamp,” due to the fact that ‘The Swamp’ desperately needs draining. But, it needs draining of all of the ‘seat-warmers’ and ‘ivory-tower experts’ in the State Department, White House, Department of Justice, US Congress, World Bank and UN (particularly UN Women) to whom I have been writing for the past decade. This is on top of the ‘seat-warmers’ and ‘ivory-tower experts’ I have been rubbing shoulders with in the IMF for the past decade, and who I have personally been observing in their ‘game-playing’. Extremism, violence, racism, misogyny, discrimination, and break-down in the rule of law is on the rise because of rampant ignorance and stupidity amongst these civil servants, coupled with a total lack of governance, transparency and accountability by their managers. This is why ICD’s \$330 million ‘training and technical assistance’ (on top of the \$1 billion operating cost of the IMF) are a total waste of taxpayer’s money.

One cannot ‘teach’ integrity, diligence, honor, honesty, and dignity to incompetent, stupid, amoral and/or lazy people. These are traits that are learned from birth by one’s care-givers, or on rare occasions innate within a person. The damage alpha-dominance feminists, who denigrate and belittle the valuable work mothers (and wives), make to society, and the general welfare, is CRIMINAL. And, their insistence that any woman who does not participate in ‘The Game’, but instead opts-out to care for their families, and raise their children, should be marginalized and ostracized if, and when, they wish to return to the work-force is discriminatory, oppressive, and rendering women more slaves to society than they have been in the past. The role that (caring and loving) mothers play in producing upstanding and honorable people and future workers cannot be under-estimated, and is ONE OF THE MOST IMPORTANT JOBS IN THE WORLD. As long as alpha-dominance women are in control of the rhetoric and feminist movement, issues such as comprehensive child-care, work-life balance, climate warming, etc. will NEVER be accorded the attention and priority needed.

In order to assure integrity, transparency and accountability in government agencies, as well as the NGOs whose mission is to oversee these agencies, it is first necessary to drain all the ‘seat-warmers’ and con-artists who are too busy ‘grappling-up-the-ladder-of-success’ in the ‘Rat-Race’ to care about doing their jobs, or fulfilling the mission of their organization. ICD is a perfect example, and ‘petri dish’, of a totally mis-managed department (from top to bottom) which is milking citizenry of their hard-earned wages, while contributing to, and escalating, the chaos in the world—in direct contradiction to its mission. The games being played by Sharmini Coorey, Gina Paone, Adrienne Thapa, Imel Yu, Carla Cullati, Jocelyn Vanderhaegen, Kathryn Nelson-Indre, Kate Phillips, and Ana Daie in collusion with IMF HR (with Kalpana Kochhar taking the lead), as well as Olivia Graham (Ethics Advisor), Geetha Ravindra (Mediator), Lois Petzhold (Ombudsman), and Sabina Blaskovic (Special Investigator) are TYPICAL of

what is going on in government agencies, and NGOs throughout “[This Town](#)” (Mark Leibovich)—and why Trump won with a promise to “drain the Swamp.”

Please see my complaint, “[Workplace Bullying in the IMF](#)” filed with IMF HR (Mark Plant and Kalpana Kohcchar), its Ombudsman, Ethics Committee, Mediator in March ’16, as well as with the ‘Special Investigator’ hired by Christine Lagarde in July 2016. The only person I ever heard back from was the Ethics Advisor, Olivia Graham, who claimed “insufficient evidence to launch an investigation.” EVERYONE implicated is well aware of my work in VAW as human rights violations, and the fact that I am THE EXPERT among the EXPERTS in that arena. They have also been duly informed that I am making an example out them, and will be pursuing them into international tribunals. However, these ‘seat-warmers’ are all so sure that they are part of the protected members of society and can get away with even the most heinous of crimes—because they do. Unfortunately, since these ‘ladies’ are getting away with their ‘game-playing’ right under everyone’s noses, they are demonstrating the extent to which the IMF is run like a mafia and protection racket—implicating all of its employees in criminal offenses and their cover-ups. Unfortunately, the IMF is not alone, but rather exemplary of what is going on in all the NGOs, as seen in the case of intellectual property theft and rape of Phyliss Chelser by a UN official, and the cover-up by UN employees, on top of my own.

This situation is a perfect example of how, and why, placing women in positions of power DOES NOT promote equality or democratic principles—and why women have traditionally been excluded from positions of power in the first place. The bullying games of Thapa and ICD’s ‘HR Team’, and its cover-up by Coorey and IMF HR is a perfect example of how and why the ‘seat-warmers’ and incompetent workers are colluding in order to rid the work-place of the competent, hard-working, and intelligent workers. The reliable, diligent people make the ‘slackers-n-slothers’ look bad, so of course they want to purge them from their midst.

The first head-hunter I met with in ’09, upon my return to Washington, and the remunerated work-force, told me she was going to have a hard time finding me a job, because anyone interviewing me would be afraid that in 6 months I would have their jobs. And, time and time again this has been my problem everywhere I have worked, and in every interview, I have had. I am having the same problem in the restaurant industry as I have had in the development community—which is also inundated with TERRIBLE management. One of the residual, and negative, effects of alpha-dominance feminism, and their contention that placing women in positions of power, is that they are reinforcing the machistic belief that the administrative function (in the work-place and home) is ‘unimportant’. Administrative positions are not properly appreciated in the workplace or society. It is the belief that these jobs are ‘unimportant’ are can done by “any idiot” that organizations are justifying the nepotism networks which are ‘dishing out the jobs’ to the lazy, incompetent ‘seat-warmers’, which in turn are bullying everyone into submission and silence. No one dares to complain, because if they do, they become a target of the bullying networks who will ‘get rid of them’, while those in power (managers and courts) turn a blind-eye to all evidence of wrong-doing.

This is precisely the ‘Game’ that Adrienne Thapa, Kate Phillips, Ana Daie, and Gina Paone are playing with Sharmini Coorey, Kalpana Kochhar, Olivia Graham, Geetha Ravindra, Lois Petzhold, and Sabina Bloskovitz turning a blind-eye. I have presented the IMF with a comprehensive analysis and two case studies of bullying within the IMF—a problem I have been told since entering employment there is “of crisis proportions”—yet EVERYONE brushes aside my report as ‘unimportant’? The bad-faith of the various actors in ignoring ‘smoking gun’ evidence of bullying exposes the collusion of IMF Management in supporting and maintaining an oppressive work-place, so that in turn NO ONE will dare protest or dissent over the IMF’s oppressive practices and policies in middle and low-income countries. And, in

light of the failure of Deputy Directors and Division Chiefs in ICD to protest to the rampant mismanagement and bullying within their department, for fear of reprisal is a perfect example of how this tactics is used in maintaining the oppressive matrix.

Phyliss Chesler in her book *Women's Inhumanity to Woman* explains all the bullying tactics of women (which the alpha-feminists are very adept and prolific in using), but is perplexed why fathers do not protect their offspring from their bullying mothers. However, what she fails to understand is that most men, alpha-linear thinking ones particularly, simply do not understand the nuances of social interactions and communications of abusive women, and do not know how to protect their daughter, nor themselves from the back-stabbing manipulations. She also fails to understand how, and why, the failure of women within the feminist movement to counter-attack, alpha-dominance feminism is just like the omission of action of men in protecting daughters. Not only does Chelser (who walked out of my presentation "[VAW as Human Rights Violations](#)" at the Battered Mother's Custody Conference (BMCC XI) in '15, 10 minutes after it started) talk about the bullying she was subjected to by the feminists in writing her book. One of my big deceptions was observing to what extent speakers and attendees, attended the conference in order to socialize and pass out business cards. I observed this same phenomenon at the IMF/WB Spring Meeting '16—again with dismay, above all since I was beginning to notice another trend.

But, feminist/activists such as Anne-Marie Slaughter ([book](#)) and Leslie Morgan Steiner ([book](#)) expose the same problems in their books, writing and speeches. Unfortunately, these women fail to DO ANYTHING about the bullying or the bullies—and become complicit to the abuses of power of their contemporaries, and the chaos they are producing. Anne-Marie Slaughter, who is the President of 'New America', also held positions of influence and power as Dean of Princeton's School of Public Policy, Director of Public Policy at the State Department, and President of the American Society of International Law. She and I possess much of the same rhetoric and commonalities in our ideological base, but not only is she DOING NOTHING to address or rectify the problems, but she is enriching herself, and the other employees of 'New America'. She is a perfect example of how those in power are unable to translate their rhetoric to reality due to their lack of integrity and strength of character in failing to denounce, and counter-attack, the alpha-dominance, bullying feminists. The cases I bringing against Anne-Beatrix Keller and IMFFA, as well as Adrienne Thapa and ICD, on top of my public denouncement of the 'window-dressing' domestic violence (DV) initiatives and programs of the IMF, World Bank, and UN. Slaughter should be calling out Lagarde, Kim, and Gonsales, and demanding accountability, instead of climbing into bed with them with the 'window-dressing' NGO 'New America'. Trump won with a promise to "drain The Swamp" because people like Slaughter, and NGOs like 'New America' are too busy partying and cashing paychecks-and-pensions from shareholders or taxpayers to DO THEIR JOBS.

As I told 'queen-for-a-day' Imel Yu and Kathryn Nelson-Indre when they had me black-listed from attending the IMF/World Bank Annual Meetings in '16 "not only have I shown the world (in my coverage of the Spring Meetings 6 months prior¹) that I could do a better job of running ICD than Adrienne Thapa or Sharmini Coorey, but I could do a better job of running the IMF than Christine Lagarde!" Michael Lewis was right in his "One-on-One with Christine Lagarde," when he said she was being set-up as the 'fall-guy' when the 'House of Cards' in 'The Swamp' comes tumbling down on everyone's head. And, when financial markets and banking systems finally collapse again, Lagarde is going to be very embarrassed when she must explain why the only person at the IMF to know WHY, AND WHAT TO DO ABOUT IT, was fired by a lazy, incompetent 'queen-for-a-day' secretary, made Office Manager—whose claim to fame is typing 75wpm, and is "known for sexually harassing men."

On the day Imel Yu and Kathryn Nelson-Indre decided to prevent me from attending the Annual Meetings, I had spent the entire morning in DC Landlord/tenant courts (after putting up with 4 months of

THEIR ‘game-playing’) collecting evidence with which to challenge the defense of the American government in *Gonzales Lenahan vs. USA*, 2011, the 1st jurisprudence on VAW as a Human Rights Violations—once I can find a lawyer, or law firm with the BALLS to submit the cases and write amicus briefs for them. Additionally, in what ended up being an 8-month battle in DC Landlord/tenant court, I was able to produce the evidence needed in order to launch a full-scale investigation into the predatory nature of the American court system, and the systemic violation of rights within them—see my letter to [Jeff Sessions](#), noting that what I am calling for is what former President Obama should have initiated during his tenure. The fact that Obama did NOTHING to challenge and dismantle the New Jim Crow during his 8-years, and two term, presidency just demonstrates to what extent his Administration “sold-out” to the dysfunctional, oppressive, and extremist *status quo* in the US.

During my 7-year tenure in the IMF, while all the ‘experts’ were busy jet-setting around the world, passing out their business cards, promoting their newest book, and having affairs, I was working 24/7 reading and UNDERSTANDING all the reports and books that they SHOULD BE reading and UNDERSTANDING, but are not. At present, I am in *déjà vu* mode with the economist in the IMF and my class-mates in international econ. 101 at GWU in ’85. I was told to ‘drop’ the course because “even econ. majors failed at least once.” Not only did I obtain a 98% on the mid-term, but I taught the course to my classmates who all passed the final as well as the course. As I told my classmates at the time, “forget EVERYTHING Dr. Dunn has said. He is complicating his subject matter too much.” The callate tonta game that EVERYONE in the IMF played with me during my 7 years there, particularly ICD, is the same game my lawyers and Spanish courts played with me in ’07-’12. It is also the same game my ex-husband and his family played with me my entire marriage, and the same game my mother and younger sister have played with me my entire life. So I am well familiar with the tactics, as well as the fact that it is motivated by stupidity and jealousy on the part of the bullies—rather than any veracity of my stupidity. In fact, anyone who thinks being a ‘genius’ is something to ‘aspire’ to, is sadly mistaken. Not only does it enable one to “see” what others cannot, but it attracts vicious, viperous back-stabbers like ‘bees to a honey pot’.

As [court documents](#) in my divorce prove, not only am I of “above average intelligence”, but I am “sensitive and see with great clarity what is happening around me, as well as that I “see” all the details, as well as the ‘Big Picture’. I can assure EVERYONE I am far from being the stupid idiot they are trying so hard to convince themselves that I am. In fact, not only have I proven to the world that I am my [father’s](#) daughter. But, I am also my grandfather’s grand-daughter (see my blogs [Harper Lee’s Passing: A Legend Dies, But Not Sa Raison d’Etre](#)). Additionally, I have proven to the world that I am as brilliant as others in my family-tree, namely John Dickinson (Penman of the Revolution), John Paul Jones (Father of the American Navy), Winston Churchill, and Thomas Wilcox (author of the Puritan Manifesto, aka Admonitions to Parliament, 1572). I do believe that in the ‘Wonderland of Alice’ paradigm in which we live ‘Trumps’ Adrienne Thapa’s claim to fame of 75wpm typing, Sharmini Coorey’s PhD, and Christine Lagarde’s Esq. While my writing are similar to Dickinson and Wilcox, the geo-political trajectories of my life are similar to John Paul Jones. And, if I am alive today it is because I possess the same fighting spirit, ability of self-preservation, and strategic and tactical intelligence of John Paul.

As I explained to Mark Lewis in my phone conversation with him in June ‘16 (as a concerned global citizen, and after my observations of the IMF during my attendance of their Spring Meetings), I have an OBLIGATION to denounce the predatory paradigm ICD is promoting with its ‘window-dressing’ technical assistance and training programs (a problem I particularly observed during my attendance of the Committee for Capacity Building (CCB) Meeting, and pre-meetings in ’15, during my tenure in ICDSE). The number of staff ICDSE employs in order to count the number of courses given, with little cognitive analysis of the effect these courses are having on economies is INCREDIBLE. And, Robert Powell’s

condescending attitude towards me during my tenure in ICDSE as a ‘stupid-idiot’ is more proof as to the incompetence of IMF staff (rather than ‘proof’ of my ‘stupidity’). The idea of ‘ivory-tower’ economists and HR personnel in the IMF that just because I became a ‘stay-at-home-mom’ and ‘trophy-wife’ (instead of having ‘opted-out’ of their ‘Rat-Race’) transformed me from a ‘genius’ into a ‘babbling idiot’ is LUDICRIOUS!!

As Richard Nixon so aptly stated “You can fool all of the people some of the time; some of the people all of the time. But, you cannot fool all of the people all of the time.” And, as [incidents such as the egg-throwing at Mark Lewis while Res Rep in Turkey](#), and comments on the youtube video suggesting that grenades or axes should have been thrown instead, **should serve as a warning to EVERYONE within the IMF as to the personal consequences and dangers that exist due to their ‘ostrich-playing’**. As I have repeatedly explained to IMF Security guards, THEY should be the first to protest against the ‘ivory-tower’ ‘game-playing’ of IMF staff. Because when violence in the streets erupts, it is they who will be on the ‘front-line of fire’ against the angry mobs armed with ‘grenades and axes’. Unfortunately, as repeatedly seen in history until violence in the streets, and raping and pillaging in homes begin, the ‘protected’ members of society will turn a blind-eye to even the most heinous of crimes by their contemporaries.

And, while some activists, like Wendy Murphy, are suggesting that I incite women into violent protest, **inciting ANYONE into violence is the LAST thing I will do**. In 2010 a lobbyist for the National Coalition Against Domestic Violence (NCADV) told me that what was needed was a “new civil rights movement.” And, since any effective ‘movement’ needs a political platform and ideological base, I “rolled up my sleeves” researched ALL the various arenas and produced the evidence and rhetoric needed for the new “revolution. Unfortunately, I have found out to what extent EVERYONE is more interested in ‘becoming famous’, getting their books published, and enriching themselves financially; than finding solutions or producing concrete results for victims. The ‘fathers rights’ initiatives (not to be confused with the ‘pedophile rights’ initiatives) are correct in their assessment of the DV industry—it is an industry more interested in making money off the suffering of victims, than in protecting or defending them. The reason that people resort to violence is that they are goaded into it by bullying networks, and the failure of ‘authorities’ to take action. If anyone examines the profiles of ‘terrorists’, be they white mass shooters or ‘brown’ suicide bombers, their past, and experience as victims of domestic violence is always omnipresent.

One of the saddest stories of the consequences for IMF staff of the paradigm the IMF, World Bank and UN are maintaining and promoting was the killing of the son of former ICDGP Director Effie Psalida ([Alexandros Peterson](#)) in Afghanistan in 2014. Not only has US military interests been a major influence in the escalation of violence in the region for decades, but the American alpha-dominance feminists are actively ‘adding fuel to the fire’ in the ‘exportation’ of their dysfunctional and oppressive ideologies to countries around the world. While it is the responsibility of ICDSE to be evaluating the effectiveness of ICD’s training programs and technical assistance, it is ICDGP which is the ‘motor’ behind those programs, as it is they who are procuring much of the funding for them. And, while Robert Powell is the typical white, male-supremacists, and therefore in ‘his nature’ to be promoting the current oppressive paradigm, in my limited knowledge of Marc Lewis, he appeared to be a conscientious, hard-working employee—albeit a victim of the ‘techy liberalism’ of Bill Gates and Microsoft in collusion with the IMF IT department—who is “in with the wrong crowd.”

In June ’16, I contacted Lewis and advised him to read my blogs, because as I told Holger Floerkemeier in Oct. ’16, if, and when I come after anyone it’s a “frontal attack” rather than the back-stabbing BS so prevalent in ICD, and elsewhere in ‘The Swamp’. Once the ‘House of Cards’ everyone in the IMF, World

Bank, and UN, in collusion with American and European governments is holding up, comes crashing down, and ‘Truth Commissions’ are formed to investigate what happened, Marc Lewis—along with others in ICD—are going to have some difficult questions to answer. The defense of “I did not know” will be of no value, because as you may note in my ‘Open Letter’ blogs everyone has been notified of their part in maintaining the ‘House of Cards’. And, while I recognize their prerogative in ignoring me, and continuing with ‘habitual custom’, they will be held accountable for their actions. And, as I repeatedly state in my blogs, I would prefer facing international tribunals rather than blood-thirsty mobs, who are not even interested in listening to excuses.

One of the many ‘players’ I have contacted in the past decade, in ‘The Swamp’ in my efforts to OBLIGATE American Consulates around the world to START DOING THEIR JOBS (by launching a Congressional Oversight Hearing on the State Department’s incompetence) is [Dee Martin](#), a board member of the Feminist Majority Foundation (FMF), and Founding Partner of the Policy Resolution Group at Bracewell, LLP. However, while Ms. Martin found my analysis and argumentation of the issues IMPECCABLE, she required a \$20,000 retainer fee “to start,” with the final price tag in the hundreds of thousands, if not millions. (Of course I do not have this money because EVERYONE keeps trying to marginalize and oppress me, as well as defraud me of the little money I am able to save.) And, when I suggested that FMF could ‘foot the bill’ for the ‘Oversight Hearing’ she responded that FMF is too busy ‘helping women in Afghanistan’. During one of the seminars in the IMF World Bank Spring Meeting, 2016 an African woman from the audience explained how women in Africa are being turned into slaves by the western-style feminism and women’s rights movement. (See my blog [Men, Women & Sex Ed for the Feminists: Observations of a CSO Rep at the IMF/WB Spring Meetings – Part 13](#)). The damage alpha-feminists and their psychopathic organizations are creating in societies around the world CANNOT BE UNDERESTIMATED.

In the Town Hall Meeting after the 2015 IMF World Bank Annual Meetings, I stood up and asked Christine Lagarde the following question,

One of the greatest factors “disempowering women” is the failure of governments to protect victims of domestic violence, with victims being revictimized at rates of 70% in courts around the world.

Another key problem is that progressive laws in the West are not being effectively implemented – further disempowering women.

One of the main issues has been conflict of interest between donors, NGOs, and victim’s rights. Another problem has been the lack of social inclusion of victims, as well as a failure to develop mass constituencies on women’s private rights issues.

In order to develop solutions, victims & civil societies need to be empowered. Has the IMF looked at issues women are facing in the courts, how and why they are being dis-empowered, and what actions the IMF might take to address the issues?

At the time, Madame Lagarde responded that my question was more under the purview of the World Bank, than IMF. However, while I begged to differ at the time (as well as now) I recognized it was my challenge to explain to Lagarde and IMF economists how, and why, my question falls as much under the purview of the IMF as it does the World Bank (and UN). And, in my report “FfD: A Midsummer’s Night Dream” and “State of the Union during the Demise of Democracy” as well as blogs series in 2016ⁱⁱ I explain in great detail and meticulous precision why, and how my question are of equal concern to these

three organizations. Their failure to heed my words demonstrates to what extent ‘policy-makers’ at the highest levels are only interested in their paychecks and pensions rather than fulfilling the mandates of their organizations—and the world be damned. Each year taxpayers are dishing out almost \$10 billion dollars to salaries of IMF, World Bank and UN employees to do NOTHING other than churn out reports, promote their newest book, and give thousand-dollars an hour speeches. The manner in which the development community is enriching themselves while economies and societies spiral out of control is DISGUSTING as well as CRIMINAL.

Please see my complaint, “[Workplace Bullying in the IMF](#)” filed with IMF HR (Mark Plant and Kalpana Kohchar), its Ombudsman, Ethics Committee, Mediator, and ‘Special Investigator’ hired by Christine Lagarde in July 2016. The only person I ever heard back from was the Ethics Advisor, Olivia Graham, who claimed “insufficient evidence to launch an investigation.” ICD is a ‘petrie dish’ of how and why NGOs are ineffective in fulfilling their mandates, as well as how the mafia networks within them are supporting and encouraging bullying, sexual harassment, and labor rights violations. EVERYONE in the IMF (and World Bank and UN) believe that they are protected by ‘diplomatic immunity’ for even the most heinous of crimes. However, what they fail to understand is that their ‘immunity’ exists so that they will not be unduly influenced by government officials in taking actions which will enable them to fulfill their mandates. It does NOT exist so that their crimes will go unpunished.

It is common knowledge in the IMF, and ICD that I have been working on violence against women (VAW) as human rights violations for the past decade—ever since Spanish family courts, in collusion with my lawyers, illegally took my children, defrauded me of all my assets, and threw me on the streets with nothing but the clothes on my back in their efforts to intimidate and silence my ‘dissent’ of the attempts upon my life by my ex-husband in ’07. My ex is one of the ‘crash-and-burn’ bankers responsible for unstable and corrupt banking systems, and who destroyed his career in Colombia as Director of the Treasury Department of Banco Ganadero (subsidiary of Spanish multi-national Banco Bilbao Vizcaya Argentaria, BBVA) in ’03. Unbeknownst to me at the time, upon our return to Madrid in ’04 he started money-laundering for his brother and cousin’s (guardia civil) human-trafficking and prostitution business in Spain.

At the same time I came up with the idea for Global Expats, whose revenue generating portion is its website, www.global-xpats.com. The concept of the platform is a cross between Yelp.com, Tripadvisor.com, Facebook.com, and LinkedIn.com with projections of \$1billion/yr. revenues. When I showed these projections to my ex, and then was to speak with a business developer in Microsoft, he in collusion with my webdesigners in Florida cyber-jacked my project and his violence and attempts upon my life escalated to where I knew it was only a matter of time before he killed me. As my letter to the American Ambassador in October ’07 (after having presented myself 3 times to the Consulate) clearly documents, I saw with great clarity the violation of my rights by my lawyers and courts from the onset (see table of infraction of my rights). And, while Amnesty International estimated my chance of survival was ¼ of 1% in ’08 (due to the incompetence of all the NGOs, Amnesty International included, in Spain and globally), I stood my ground, and meticulously documented EVERY scumbag manipulation of my lawyers—promising I would be taking them to the international courts. They all just responded “what do

we care lady, we do this all the time. Who are you going to tell?” And, effectively EVERYONE is covering up for domestic violence, as well as the scumbag lawyers who are laughing all the way to the bank while women and children are raped, tortured, and sex-trafficked. Trump response to White House staffers, Rob Porter and David Sorenson, accused of domestic violence with “he is a ‘good guy’ and said ‘he didn’t do it’” is TYPICAL. Trump used the same ‘defense’ when he was accused of sexual harassment. Washington is over-flowing with sexual predators who are ALL covering-up for each other with—“he’s a ‘good guy’ and said he didn’t do it.”

Leaving my children in Spain, and returning to the USA in '09 was the hardest thing I have ever done. However, as one woman living a similar experience told me “I do not want to scare you, but you could end up dead in a ditch.” I told her “I know that! Go tell the jack-asses in the courts and Consulates.” If my children are killed EVERYONE implicated will spend the rest of their lives in jail as accessories to murder. I naively thought that I would find NGOs willing to help me and liberate my children. However, I like all the other victims out there have found all of these organizations (IMFFA included) are nothing other than ‘window-dressing’ (as states the UN report “Indepth Study on All Forms of Violence Against Women” and only exist so that PhDs may collect a handsome salary, while they cover-up for all the corruption in the courts and legal community.

As I repeatedly point out in my reports and blogs, if every country of the world aspires to excessively consume like Americans (in their ‘Fractured Fairytale American Dream’); then our planet will assure its demise within one or two generations. However, man may even destroy the planet before that with nuclear wars in its present geo-political trajectory. Additionally, I explain how the technical assistance and training programs of ICD are nothing more than ‘window-dressing’, covering up for the elevated level of negligence and corruption in banking systems and financial markets, in addition to finance ministries around the world which they have an obligation to oversee—at a cost of \$330 million per year to taxpayers.

Capacity Building MUST focus on Diligence, Integrity, Transparency, Accountability, and Justice. One of my more interesting (and encouraging) assignments in the IMF was in the Financial Integrity Group (FIG) under the direction of Jodie Myer. Not only did an assignment of archiving their filing system provide me with the opportunity to examine, in detail, the work of FIG, but I organized the personal papers of its Director accumulated over a two-year period, and was impressed with the ‘diversity’ of the ‘doodling’ information he collected. Unfortunately, Myer has left the IMF for work in the private sector. Instead of allowing people like Jody Myer to leave the IMF, ICD should be working closely with FIG (whose ‘capacity’ and funding should be enormously increased), and assisting NGOs such as FIBGAR

and ILOCAD in bringing Transparency and Accountability through a holistic (legislative, judicial and executive) approach.

While you, like all of the other ‘public authorities’ and ‘civil servants’ I have contacted in the past decade, are at liberty to ignore me (hoping I will go away) and throw my correspondence in the waste-bin. I wish to notify you (as I have consistently done in all of my communications to public authorities and civil servants in the past) that “[ignorance of the law \(and failure to read\) is no defense](#)”. In the present political situation within the American government, journalists are increasingly acknowledging that the ‘defense’ of “I was just doing my job” is eerily similar to “I was just following orders” (by German Nazis). And, while EVERYONE implicated in the ENORMOUS amount of negligence and corruption I have been documenting in judicial, executive, and legislative branches of governments in the past decade have been using this defense, the Nuremberg Trials clearly demonstrated the illegitimacy of that argumentation.

Financial markets are once again on the brink of collapse, and much of this is due to decades of the IMF’s ‘bowing-and-scraping’ to American and European increasingly risky banking systems and predatory business communities; controlled by good ‘ol boy networks and bankruptcy building businessmen like Donald Trump. My analysis of the ineffectiveness of the IMF (and World Bank and UN) in my coverage of the IMF/World Bank Spring and Annual Meetings as well as US Presidential elections in 2016ⁱⁱⁱ **is what ICD’s Strategic Evaluation Division (ICDSE) and the IMF’s Committee for Capacity Building (CBB) SHOULD BE analyzing; instead of simply counting the number of technical assistance and training programs ICD is distributing each year. ICDSE’s Director, Robert Powell is an ardent supporter of Donald Trump, and is part of the ol’ boy/white supremacist network that put him in, and is keeping him in, the White House. He, and ICD’s ‘window-dressing’ programs, are perfect examples of how, and why, Bretton Woods initiatives are sustaining the dysfunctional and corrupt paradigm currently at the reins of power in the USA and Europe.**

When an investigation is launched into why the IMF is failing to fulfill its mandate, Robert Powell and all the members of the CCB, will have some VERY tough questions to answer—with me pointing fingers at the major and minor players involved. Please note that I attended ALL of the CCB and pre-CCB meetings in ’15, and was dismayed to find all the ‘experts’ present were a perfect example of “too many chefs spoil the soup.” ~~In my international econ. 101 course at GWU in ’85, I was told to “drop the course because even econ majors failed at least once.” Not only did I obtain a 98% on the mid-term, but I taught the course to my classmates who all passed the final as well as the course. As I told my classmates at the time, “forget EVERYTHING Dr. Dunn has said, he is complicating his subject matter too much.” At present I am in *déjà vu* mode with all the IMF and World Bank economists looking down their noses at me, while all my predictions are coming to pass. My ex-husband played the same “callete tonta” game with me our entire marriage, because as stated in [court documents](#) for my divorce, I am far from being the stupid idiot everyone contends. When our useless Spanish marriage counselor gave me her report in ’04 she told me that “I see all the tiny details as well as the ‘Big Picture’”—a fact which was no news to me. I have always known I had inherited my [father’s brilliance](#), which is more of a curse than gift, because it attracts viperous, jealous parasites likes ‘bees to a honey pot’. My ex-husband and my mother are perfect examples.~~

And, my black-listing from attendance from the IMF/World Bank Annual Meetings in ’16 (and again in ’17) by ‘queen-for-a-day’ ICD secretaries, Imel Yu and Kathryn Nelson-Indre; instead of intimidating and silencing me, has only ‘added fuel to the fire’. When I went to pick-up my CSO Rep badge for the Annual Meetings in Oct. ’16 and had to put up with Imel Yu’s condescending BS, it was the ‘straw that broke the camel’s back’. I told her if she even ‘tried’ to black-list me from attending the meetings, like IMF HR was doing in my applications for employment with the IMF, she would be looking at serious legal problems in

the future. I may have had to put up with condescending idiot IMF ‘queen-for-a-day’ in my 7-year tenure there, who were threatened by my competence, but as a CSO Rep it is THEY who better being bowing-and-scraping’ to ME. This is particularly true after my scathing review of the IMF during the Spring Meetings and my realization to what extent the IMF (and World Bank and UN, along with the US and European governments) are the MOTOR behind the problems that plague our planet. That day, I had spent the entire morning (and the prior 4 months) in DC Landlord/tenant courts putting up with the same BS from court personnel, as well as the two legal clinics there—and am sick and tired of dealing with staffers who are TOTALLY INCOMPETENT, and milking citizenry of their hard-earned money with their stupid games. There are over 10 million children around the world being raped, beaten and sex-trafficked by custodial fathers, because of ‘queen-for-a-day’ ‘civil servants’ like Imel Yu, Elizabeth Elliott, Carla Cullati, Jocelyn Vanderhaegen, Adrienne Thapa, etc., etc. See the case of [Jimmy Ryan](#), [Schlesinger](#), [Sims](#), and my newest case, [Andrea Wainer](#) whose daughters are being sex-trafficked in Bali by their father. Another ‘queen-for-a-day’ IMF employee who needs to be “drained from The Swamp” is Giselle in FIN. While I was having to put up with her BS when she was jerking Gerd Schwartz around on his expense report in Sept-Oct. ’15, I was dealing with the same BS from ‘queen-for-a-day’ secretaries in UN Women, [in my](#) and [Cindy Dumas’s](#) efforts for them to DO THEIR JOBS.

The legal profession is over-flowing with incompetent, stupid lawyers (70-90%) and DC courts are TRAINING law students in the ‘fine art’ of violating citizen’s rights!?! While Imel Yu, Kathryn Nelson-Indre, along with all the other incompetent ‘queen-for-a-day’ secretaries in ICD, with whom I worked during my 4-year tenure there, have for decades been paid hefty salaries to ‘seat-warm’; I have been working 24/7 gathering evidence to launch a full-scale investigation into the corruption in court systems—see my reports and correspondences on www.warondomesticterrorism.com and [letter to Jeff Sessions](#) calling for an DOJ investigation into the [New Jim Crow](#) in the USA. Additionally, while these ‘seat-warmers’ were illicitly enriching themselves at the expense of taxpayers in ’16, I was lobbying voters in the US to vote against Donald Trump, as I knew his Administration would degrade into the mess it is at present. As I explained to EVERYONE at the time, I can clean-up the nepotism networks in ‘The Swamp’, but I cannot ‘clean-up’ the ‘craziness’ of Donald Trump (see my application for the position of [Secretary of Management at the State Department](#)). And, when the blood-baths start in the streets of DC, and other cities around the world, my calling for dissolution of the American government will be the only peaceful solution (see my blog [Cost of Corruption: Open Letter to President, Barak Obama, 9/11 was the 1st Worst Day in America, 11/9 Was the 2nd Worst Day!](#)).

For over a decade I have been tracking and exposing the nepotism networks within the legal, business and political communities which are empowering the most amoral and criminal elements in society, while silencing and oppressing those who denounce them. In my reports, correspondences, and blogs on the Internet, not only do I expose the ‘window-dressing’¹ NGOs in the domestic violence arena (ie. American Overseas Domestic Crisis Center ([AODVCC](#)), George Washington University’s [DV LEAP](#), National Coalition Against Domestic Violence ([NCADV](#)), Women’s Link Worldwide ([WLW](#)), [Federación de Asociación de Mujeres Separadas y Divorciadas](#), etc.), which are covering-up for the negligence, misogyny, discrimination, and corruption within family court systems, with their empty-rhetoric and bullying of victims. But, I also expose the ‘ol boy/ol’ gal bankruptcy business building networks within the corporate world, as well as amongst the capital venturists in the USA and Europe—in my quest for funding for [Global Expats](#). The inability of the Trump Administration’s to ‘manage’ itself, as well as the country; in addition to the elevated level of domestic violence perpetrators in his Administration is ‘par

for the course' within the corporate and political world, as well as within the 'development community'(IMF, World Bank, and UN included).

One of the newest 'window-dressing' NGOs in 'The Swamp' is Senator John McCain's NGO "[McCain Institute for International Leadership](#)." This NGO is a perfect example of the hypocrisy of the NGOs in 'The Swamp'. If EVERYONE was not trying to silence, destroy and oppress anyone with the COURAGE to SPEAK-OUT and LEAD, then there would be NO NEED for an Institute for International Leadership in the first place. ([New America](#) and [Center for Global Development](#) are two other perfect examples of this type of hypocrisy and wasteful allocation of resources. If the IMF, World Bank, and UN were doing their jobs with a minimum of efficiency and integrity, there would be NO NEED for 'New America's' Bretton Woods. In 2007, when I saw that my lawyers and judges in Spain were doing EVERYTHING in their power to cover-up the escalating violence in my home, and repeated attempts upon my life and person by my then husband; I contacted my Consulates in Madrid (American and French, on top of Spanish NGOs) requesting that they assure that my and my children's rights were protected in all court proceedings. Not only did my Consulates refuse my requests for assistance, but they unlawfully claimed that they were unable to assist me "under the law." (See my letter to the [American Abroad Caucus](#) ('13), [Hillary Clinton](#) ('14) and [Under Secretary of Management Kennedy](#) ('14) at the State Department (along with all the other correspondences posted on my activism website [www.warondomesticterrorism.com](#)) which explains the obligation of American Consulates to protect and defend the rights, property, and lives of their citizens living and travelling abroad.)

As the UN report "Indepth Study of All Forms of Violence Against Women (VAW)" clearly states, "while women commit a small proportion of intimate partner violence, they are involved to a greater degree in the perpetration of harmful traditional practices and in trafficking." **And, my mother is a PERFECT examples of alpha-dominance women who are perpetrating the 'harmful traditional practices' which support and sustain VAW in all its forms.** In 'Oct. '07 I asked my mother (an active member in the Arizona and Texas Republican parties for over 50 years), if she would ask her long-time friend, [Mike Hellon](#) (one of McCain's campaign managers in the '07 presidential elections) Senator McCain's office communicate the responsibility of the American Consulate in Madrid and the dire situation I and my children were in, noting that Amnesty International estimated my chance at survival was ¼ of 1%. She responded "McCain wouldn't want to 'get involved' during an election year." At the same time [Representative Chris Christie was "getting involved" in David Goldman's case in Brazil](#). While I would go to 'Hell and back' for my children, my mother would never lift a finger for her children, or grand-children, and would even be more than happy to assist ANYONE who wished to harm or destroy them.

My mother is a perfect example of the narcissistic, psychopathic women in power who view everyone as a pawn to be used in their sick games, and manipulations in order to gain power and control over those around them. In the past decade, as I fight for my life and that of my children, she has gone to the most extraordinary lengths to destroy me—because it is in her nature, see my blog "["Because It Is in My Nature' said the Scorpion to the Frog.](#)" My older sister and I both fled her psychopathic abuse in the '80s, seeking refuge in Europe. Unfortunately, I "jumped from the frying pan into the fire" with my ex-husband and his truly sick, psychopathic family. My ex-husband is one of the 'crash-and-burn' bankers responsible for unstable banking systems and financial markets. After destroying his career as Director of the Treasury Department of Banco Ganadero in Colombia (subsidiary of his employer Banco Bilbao Vizcaya Argentaria (BBVA) for over 25 years) in 2002, he decided to start money-laundering for his brother and cousins human trafficking and prostitution business in Spain. If John McCain's office had been assisting me, instead of ignoring me, for the past decade (see [my correspondence to him](#) after Donald Trump won

the US elections); then not only would he have maybe won the US presidential elections in '07, but Donald Trump would not be president today. Additionally, the mafia business of my ex-husband's family would have been exposed, preventing the human-trafficking and prostitution of thousands and thousands of men, women and children in Spain in the past decade.

In '07 my ex-husband promised me I would be obligated to prostitute myself in order to survive, if I left him. At the time I thought his threats were just part of his 'crazy' ranting-and-raving; but he knew exactly what he was talking about, as my job search in the past decade is testament (see my blog "[Opting Back In: Not As Peachy As it Seems for the Divorcée](#)"). My case against the IMF Family Association (IMMFA), for wrongful and illegal termination in 2011, under the direction of Anne-Beatrix Keller Semadeni, is another example of vicious psychopaths in currently in power. James Love and Joseph Stiglitz of Knowledge Ecology International may think that termination of Anne-Beatrix Keller as Director of Development in '16 absolved them from being accessory to the crimes of Keller, but they are sadly mistaken. Stiglitz, just like everyone else in 'The Swamp' needs to learn how to "put their money where their mouth is" as explained in my blogs "[Open Letter to Joseph Stiglitz, Time to Start "Re-writing the Rules," Instead of "Playing the Same Old Game!"- Part 1](#)" and "[Part 2](#)." Additionally, my bullying and wrongful termination by Adrienne Thapa from ICD in '15, as well as the cover-up of the crimes of Thapa² (and Keller) by Kalapana Kochhar, Geetha Ravindra, Olivia Graham, Lois Petzhold, Sabina Blaskovic, and Sharmini Coorey for the past 2 years are other perfect examples of how, and why, women are responsible for maintaining VAW in societies (see my report [Workplace Bullying in the IMF](#) and my [letter to the ED's of the IMF and World Bank](#)). Domestic violence advocates and NGOs are desperately trying to maintain the myth that DV and VAW are 'poor' people, and 'poor' countries problems, because they do not want exposed that women can be just, if not more, abusive than men. Women use psychological warfare, rather than physical or sexual violence, to maintain power and control in society, and the alpha-dominance feminists DO NOT want exposed their psychopathic tactics and manipulations, and the damage done to victims. Phyliss Chesler in her book [Woman's Inhumanity to Woman](#) and Anne-Marie Slaughter in [Unfinished Business: Women Men Work Family](#) talk about the bullying tactics of the feminists in their efforts to silence any dissent to the 'House of Cards' and oppressive regime their movement has been instrumental in producing. In '81 Betty Freidan, who launched the western feminist movement with her book, *The Feminine Mystique*, published *The Second Stage*, admonishing the feminists for the alpha-dominance their feminist movement had produced. But, her criticism fell on deaf ears, because the feminists were making too much money, and enjoyed too much fame, to care about the damage their movement was creating in societies, particularly the plight of women and children, who did not "buy" into their power games.

Unfortunately, to complicate matters further for the IMF and ICD Adrienne Thapa, full well knowing that I am headed to the international courts on issues regarding violence and discrimination against women, wrongfully terminated me in November of 2015 due to my ‘dissent’ to her bullying as Office Manager of ICD (see my blogs on HuffPost “[The Right of Passage and Right to Protest: Dead and Buried in Our Nation’s Capitol](#),” “[Lessons Learned in Our Nation’s Capitol and Global Governance](#),” “[Bullying in the Workplace and its Consequences](#),” and “[Empowering Women to Empower Themselves](#).”).

To further complicate matters for the IMF, and its employees, Thapa was my contact person with IMF HR, when Anne-Beatrix Keller Semadeni illegally and wrongfully terminated me from the IMF Family Association (IMFFA) in 2011. Keller found the work I had done in the IMFFA during my tenure there (2009-11) so good that she decided to get rid of me, and take credit for my work within IMF HR. Unfortunately, not only did Keller transfer legal liability for her actions from IMFFA board members to IMF staff in HR’s signing of a MoU the day before she illegally terminated me, but she also implicated Anne Sinclair (wife of former MD Strauss-Kahn) as accessory to her infractions (penal and civil) under IMFFA statute and the law.

Keller’s manipulations and conniving is typical of what is occurring in ‘Expat Wives Clubs’ as well as why they (with FAWCO the most grievous) one of the motors behind the dysfunctional paradigm which reigns at present. The work I did at the IMFFA was implementation of ideas I have for Global Expats, whose mission is the same as the IMFFA, except my constituency included expat families of all nationalities (apx. 300 million of the 1 billion citizens living abroad). The main revenue portion of Global Expats is its website, www.global-expats.com, and is a cross between Yelp.com, TripAdvisor.com, Facebook.com and LinkedIn.com. When I came up or the idea for the website in 2005, market research showed a \$1billion revenue potential for the platform, which is effectively what these platforms are generating at present. My ex-husband’s efforts to destroy me and my project (in order to ‘protect’ his human trafficking and prostitution business) are a perfect example of how VAW is used to dominate and oppress women, as well as how and why women (ie. Thapa and Coorey) are complicit to the crimes committed.

They, along with other implicated actors have been informed of the consequence of their actions, and omission of actions under human rights standards and international law. And, while it is their prerogative to ignore me, it is also my prerogative to pursue them (and their accessories) within the courts under penal, civil and international law.

My battles against stupidity and corruption in government agencies, and the NGOs which pretend to be overseeing them, began in Spain over 10 years ago. However, since then I have found these problems are prolific in organizations around the world, and across the board—the IMF, World Bank, and UN included. In my cases against the Spanish government (naming the American and French government “accessories after the fact” and ‘complicit’ to the crimes against humanity by their omission of action) I challenge the Spanish government’s defense in the 2nd jurisprudence of violence against women (VAW) as human rights violations, [Gonzalez Carreno vs. Spain, 2014](#). The government’s ‘defense’ in this case ridiculously contended “judicial error and a failure to exhaust all domestic remedies.”

What I demonstrate in my case, is that “judicial errors” are not “errors” at all, but rather intentional manipulations of misogynistic, corrupt and stupid lawyers, judges, court-officials, ‘civil-servants’, and ‘public authorities’. I also demonstrate that these manipulations are with the expressed intent of covering-up all evidence of domestic abuse, as well as all evidence of legal abuse, designed to silence and oppress victims. See my earliest correspondence to the [American Embassy in Madrid](#) (2007), as well as the [table](#)

[of infractions of my rights](#) (2007-'12), documenting the criminal behavior of my lawyers as well as criminal negligence of the America Embassy from the onset of the case.

‘Capacity building’ which concentrates on ‘training’ (and more ‘training’) rather than criminal and civil accountability of stupid, negligent and/or corrupt civil servants is NOTHING other than ‘smoke-screens’ designed to cover-up for corruption. And, after my attendance of the IMF/World Bank Spring Meetings, 2016, particularly the ICD presentation “[Collect More & Spend Better: The Role of Capacity Development](#),”—and realization to what extent the IMF is PART of the PROBLEM—I have been publicly denouncing the ‘capacity building’ efforts of ICD and IMF (see my blogs [Dangers of “Easy” Taxes without Governance: Observations of a CSO Rep at the IMF/WB Spring Meetings – Part 4](#), and [The Trickle Down Theory of Corruption: Observations of a CSO Rep at the IMF/WB Spring Meetings – Part 5](#)). ‘Training’ of immoral, unethical and stupid people does ABSOLUTELY NO GOOD, and is a total waste of taxpayers’ money. **Effective ‘capacity building must focus on human resource management and accountability of ‘civil servants’ and ‘public authorities’ at every level.**

While the problems and issues I have been attacking for the past decade have been prevalent in societies for thousands of years, they have been aggravated and escalated by the alpha-dominance feminists (ie. by women such as Gloria Steinem and Eleanor Smeal), as explained in my blogs on [Womentalia.com](#)³, inter-alia. The UN report “Indepth Study of All Forms of Violence Against Women (VAW)” clearly demonstrates that while women are less frequently perpetrators of VAW The problems have been further aggravated by affirmative action programs which have concentrated power in the hands of previously oppressed groups, who in turn are bullying and oppressing those ‘beneath’ them, particularly targeting previously ‘favored’ groups—with white ‘deposed trophy-wives’ at the top of their ‘hit-list’. At the international level this has translated into minority women, particularly Middle-eastern ones, promoting bullying and corruption within communities and workplaces—as explained in my report “[Workplace Bullying in the IMF](#).” Unfortunately, IMF HR, and the IMF Ethics Committee, Ombudsman, Mediator and newly appointed ‘Special Investigator’ are playing the same ‘ostrich-playing’ game as Sharmini Coorey—implicating ICD managers in the ‘illegitimacy’ of ICD management, as explained in my letter to Prince Charles, and from which I quote,

the ‘origin and legitimacy’ of government, stems from ‘natural law’ and ‘social contract’ theory, quoting from Natelson’s article “The Constitutional Contributions of John Dickinson,

*“Upon entering political society, people contributed some of their rights or powers to the central authority. Ideally, those contributed should be those in the first category: Man
“must submit his will, in what concerns all, to the will of the whole society, and “[th]e*

authority of the whole, *must be coextensive with its interests.*” *We may think of the rights contributed as one’s “alienable rights.” When all people yielded to society the power to injure others, then all could enjoy their retained rights more fully because everyone received protection from injury and freedom from fear. Everyone benefited as a result. This was the common good or the general welfare.*”

The inability of IMF managers, such as Coorey, Lewis, Powell, Dessruelle, Schwartz, Berg, Chami, etc. to understand how their failure to assure ‘protection’ of their employees ‘from injury and freedom from fear’ in order to protect the ‘general welfare’ within their department renders their ‘power and authority’ illegitimate in the same way it renders governments illegitimate when they fail to provide ‘protection’ for the citizens (or subjects) they govern.

The public-policy issues related to my case against ICD are highlighted in my Huffington Post blogs, [“The Right of Passage and Right to Protest: Dead and Buried in Our Nation’s Capitol,”](#) [“Lessons Learned in Our Nation’s Capitol and Global Governance,”](#) [“Bullying in the Workplace and its Consequences,”](#) and [“Empowering Women to Empower Themselves.”](#) Taxpayers around the world are already dishing out \$1 billion dollars each year for IMF staff to ‘game-play’ as they ‘grapple up the ladder of success’ in the ‘Rat-Race’ as well as \$330 million per year in technical assistance and ‘training’. But, to add insult to injury, they are dishing out another \$1+ million each year for ‘window-dressing’ ‘Ethics experts’ to cover-up for rampant corruption, negligence, and even criminal activity of IMF staff—**while economies around the world spiral out of control!!** The drops and volatility of global stock markets which began over a week ago, will only continue in the months to come. My analysis of charts about 1 ½ years ago indicated the DOW Jones will drop to around 8000, and perhaps as low as 4-6000, and concurs with the findings and predictions of [Jim Rogers](#) and Harry Dent about an impending Depression.

In ‘defense’ of employees within the IMF, the level of unethical and immoral behavior within their organization is a ‘historical fact’ and is only match by that found in every other agency and NGO in ‘The Swamp’! I originally came to Washington in ’81 at 17 years of age, working on Capitol Hill and then in the financial markets until I left in ’87 disgusted with the elevated level of hedonism, cocaine-snorting, indiscriminate fornication, and immorality which permeated ‘This Town’ at the time. Upon my return in ’09 (right after Obama entered Office) I was dismayed to find that NOTHING had changed, and that in fact problems had even become worse. And, in the past 9 years, while EVERYONE has been partying, jet-setting around the world, fornicating with ‘anything that moves’, promoting their newest publication, and ‘grappling up the ladder of success’ I have been working 24/7 READING and UNDERSTANDING all of the reports that the ‘ivory-tower’ experts, with the assistance of their ‘seat-warming’ brown-nosing staff have been churning out, with ABSOLUTELY NO READING COMPREHENSION!!

Donald Trump won the US elections with a promise to “drain the Swamp,” because ‘The Swamp’ desperately needs draining. And, all the ‘seat-warming’ bullies in the IMF I encountered in my 7-year tenure there (on top of all of those in the State Department, White House, and US Congress I have been challenging in my activism work) are perfect examples of the elements which need “draining” from ‘The Swamp’. Other examples can be found in the elevated level of negligence and corruption I have been challenging in Spain for the past decade, namely family courts, Consejo General del Poder Judicial, Fiscalia General del Estado, Defensor del Pueblo, Instituto de Mujer, Delegada del Gobierno para la Violencia de Genero, and Colegio de Abogados de Madrid. **Without exception, ALL of these organizations are FILLED with INCOMPETENT IDIOTS who in addition to being functionally illiterate, have absolutely NO IDEA of how ‘checks and balances’ work within a democracy.** This is why ‘democratic’ governments around the world are facing constitutional crises, [with the American government taking the LEAD.](#) **American and European governments (and IMF, World Bank and UN**

staff) need to learn to LEAD the world in Integrity, Morality, Diligence, Transparency, and Accountability instead of Stupidity, Ignorance, Immorality, Negligence, and Corruption.

When Jocelyn Vanderhaegen (who used to work in the French Embassy) told me I should be “ashamed of myself” for the letter I sent to the [French Ambassador in Madrid](#), I realized to what extent civil servants are COGNITIVELY IGNORANTS as to their DUTY and OBLIGATION to serve THE PEOPLE. While I am the first to admit my correspondences in Spanish and French to appropriate ‘public authorities’ in the past decade are certainly less than perfectly written and grammatically correct (as these are not my first languages). However, what ‘queen-for-a-day’ civil servants, such as Vanderhaegen, fail to understand is that it is the LEGAL RESPONSIBILITY of civil servants (particularly in a foreign country and jurisdiction) to UNDERSTAND the CITIZENS they SERVE (particularly VICTIMS OF ABUSES OF POWER), instead of the other way around—as Vanderhaegen contends. The bully ‘games’ going on in ICD are ‘typical’ examples of the ‘games’ being played by civil servants around the world—and why my case against ICD, and the bullies in it, is not an ‘insignificant’ “histoire entre des bonnes femmes;” but rather an important lesson in what needs to be done to combat bullying, negligence and corruption.

Instead of preventing another World War and destruction of the planet, the IMF, and all the other **Bretton Woods initiatives are assuring its demise.** While world leaders (like Jim Yong Kim, President of the World Bank, and Antonio Guterres and Ban Ki-Moon, Secretary and former Secretary General of the United Nations) are recognizing the need, and calling for, a paradigm shift in the global social order; **it is their own organizations, and the employees within them, that are preventing this paradigm shift from occurring—and in the process implicating EVERYONE within them in crimes against humanity under art. 7 of the Roma Statutes.** While EVERYONE in these organizations believe they are protected by diplomatic immunity, the Nuremburg Trials clearly demonstrated that this is NOT THE CASE.

As I explained to Holger Floerkemeier in 2015, I know many ‘important’ and wealthy people around the world, and would (have been) happy to assist ICD in procuring donor funding from them. I am highly dedicated to producing stable societies, and economies (which go hand in hand) particularly after my own turbulent life, and the damage produced by the present paradigm in which we live. My Global Expats project was even conceived in order to capitalize on the many, many connections I have globally. However, after my attendance of the IMF World Bank Spring Meetings in 2016, and discovering to what extent the IMF (and particularly ICD) are promoting unstable economies and the demise of the planet, I could not in GOOD CONSCIENCE assist ICD, but rather am obliged to denounce them. ~~As I explained to Mark Lewis in my phone conversation with him in June 2016, as a concerned global citizen (and one of the few LEADERS in ‘The Swamp’), I have an OBLIGATION to denounce the predatory paradigm ICD is promoting with its ‘window dressing’ technical assistance and training programs (a problem I particularly observed during my attendance of the Committee for Capacity Building (CCB) Meeting, and pre-meetings in 2015). The number of staff ICDSE employs in order to count the number of courses given, with little cognitive analysis of the effect these courses are having on economies is INCREDIBLE. And, Robert Powell’s condescending attitude towards me during my tenure in ICDSE as a ‘stupid idiot’ is more proof as to the incompetence of IMF staff (rather than ‘proof’ of my ‘stupidity’). The idea of ‘ivory tower’ economists and HR personnel in the IMF that just because I became a ‘stay-at-home mom’ and ‘trophy wife’ (instead of joining their ‘Rat Race’) transformed me from a ‘genius’ into a ‘babbling idiot’ is LUDICRIOUS!!~~

As Richard Nixon so aptly stated “You can fool all of the people some of the time; some of the people all of the time. But, you cannot fool all of the people all of the time.” And, as [incidents such as the egg-throwing at Mark Lewis while Res Rep in Turkey](#), and comments on the youtube video suggesting that

grenades or axes should have been thrown instead, should serve as a warning to EVERYONE within the organization. As I have repeatedly explained to IMF Security guards, THEY should be the first to protest against the 'ivory tower' 'game playing' of IMF staff. Because when violence in the streets erupts, it is they who will be facing the angry mobs and their 'grenades and axes'. Unfortunately, as repeatedly seen in history until violence in the streets, and raping and pillaging in homes begin, the 'protected' members of society will turn a blind eye to even the most heinous of crimes by their contemporaries.

One of the saddest stories of the consequences for IMF staff of the paradigm the IMF, World Bank and UN are maintaining and promoting was the killing of the son of former ICDGP Director Effie Psalida ([Alexandros Peterson](#)) in Afghanistan in 2014. Not only has US military interests been a major influence in the escalation of violence in the region for decades, but the American alpha-dominance feminists are actively 'adding fuel to the fire' in the 'exportation' of their dysfunctional and oppressive ideologies to countries around the world. One of the many 'players' I have contacted in the past decade, in 'The Swamp' in my efforts to OBLIGATE American Consulates around the world to START DOING THEIR JOBS (by launching a Congressional Oversight Hearing on the State Department's incompetence) is [Dee Martin](#), a board member of the Feminist Majority Foundation (FMF), and Founding Partner of the Policy Resolution Group at Bracewell, LLP. However, while Ms. Martin found my analysis and argumentation of the issues IMPECCABLE, she required a \$20,000 retain to start, with the final price tag in the hundreds of thousands, if not millions. (Of course I do not have this money because EVERYONE keeps trying to marginalize and oppress me, as well as defraud me of the little money I am able to save.) And, when I suggested that FMF could 'foot the bill' for the 'Oversight Hearing' she responded that FMF is too busy 'helping women in Afghanistan'. During one of the seminars in the IMF World Bank Spring Meeting, 2016 an African woman from the audience explained how women in Africa are being turned into slaves by the western style feminism and women's rights movement. (see my blog [Men, Women & Sex Ed for the Feminists: Observations of a CSO Rep at the IMF/WB Spring Meetings—Part 13](#)). The damage alpha feminists and their psychopathic organizations are creating in societies around the world CANNOT BE UNDERESTIMATED.

In the Town Hall Meeting after the 2015 IMF World Bank Annual Meetings, I stood up and asked Christine Lagarde the following question,

One of the greatest factors "disempowering women" is the failure of governments to protect victims of domestic violence, with victims being revictimized at rates of 70% in courts around the world.

Another key problem is that progressive laws in the West are not being effectively implemented—further disempowering women.

One of the main issues has been conflict of interest between donors, NGOs, and victim's rights. Another problem has been the lack of social inclusion of victims, as well as a failure to develop mass constituencies on women's private rights issues.

In order to develop solutions, victims & civil societies need to be empowered. Has the IMF looked at issues women are facing in the courts, how and why they are being dis-empowered, and what actions the IMF might take to address the issues?

At the time, Madame Lagarde responded that my question was more under the purview of the World Bank, than IMF. However, while I begged to differ at the time (as well as now) I recognized it was my challenge to explain to Lagarde and IMF economists how, and why, my question falls as much under the

~~purview of the IMF as it does the World Bank (and UN). And, in my report “FfD: A Midsummer’s Night Dream” and “State of the Union during the Demise of Democracy” as well as blogs series in 2016^{iv} I explain in great detail and meticulous precision why, and how my question are of equal concern to these three organizations. Their failure to heed my words demonstrates to what extent ‘policy makers’ at the highest levels are only interested in their paychecks and pensions rather than fulfilling the mandates of their organizations—and the world be damned. Each year taxpayers are dishing out almost \$10 billion dollars to salaries of IMF, World Bank and UN employees to do NOTHING other than churn out reports, promote their newest book, and give thousand dollars an hour speeches. The manner in which the development community is enriching themselves while economies and societies spiral out of control is DISGUSTING as well as CRIMINAL.~~

Additionally, my life-story provides several case studies for economists and policy-makers of the detrimental impact VAW is having on female populations, as well as economies and societies. First in relation to VAW when the perpetrator is a man, my story provides a perfect study of how men’s desperation to prevent wives from being gainfully employed outside the home is a form of domination, oppress, and discrimination—as highlighted in the UN report. It also demonstrates the damage and havoc predatory and corrupt banking systems and financial markets are having on those who work in them, as well as their families, in addition to consumers, economies, and societies. And, finally it demonstrates how societies, and social norms, work in collusion to cover-up VAW and exploit and silence victims. My ex-husband ‘crashed-n-burned’ in 2003 as Director of the Treasury Department of Banco Ganadero in Columbia (a subsidiary of the Spanish multi-national bank Banco Bilbao Vizcaya Argentaria (BBVA)); with ‘experts’ from BBVA headquarters in Madrid taking 9-months to unravel the ‘House of Cards’ he had built in the preceding years. Unfortunately, unbeknownst to me at the time, instead of attempting to recuperate his career he decided to begin money-laundering the proceeds of his brother and cousin’s (guardia civil) human-trafficking and prostitution business in Spain. It is for this reason that he went to the most extra-ordinary lengths to destroy my Global Expats project, whose revenue projections in 2005 were at \$1billion annually. He knew that when I found out what he was involved in, and at the head of a multi-billion dollar company, I would have the power to put a stop to his illegal activity. And, when a business development manager with Microsoft took an interest in the project his violence and abuse escalated to repeated threats and attempts upon my life.

Unfortunately, I was to learn in the past decade to what extent EVERYONE is covering-up for ALL forms of VAW. Not only did my lawyers work in collusion to cover-up all evidence of abuse and violence of my ex-husband, but they colluded to defraud me of all my assets in attempts to silence and oppress me. Then to add insult to injury, ALL of the NGOs which CLAIM to be assisting and defending the rights of women and children are in their turn covering-up the elevated level of misogyny, discrimination, negligence and corruption within court systems—thereby becoming complicit to the human rights violations of the courts and legal community. As the father’s rights initiatives (not to be confused with ‘pedophile rights’ advocates) succinctly claim, the domestic violence arena is nothing more than an industry through which Phd and other ‘experts’ can enrich themselves at the expense of victims. As the UN report “Good Practices in Combating and Eliminating Violence Against Women” states,

The necessity of inter-agency cooperation and coordination in this field has been stressed for over two decades, since the creation of services and support for victims and sanctions for perpetrators requires the interlinking of a number of agencies and services. It has also become apparent that support to women, who often need to cope with a range of practical issues, will frequently involve provision of assistance to negotiate the many bureaucracies associated with criminal and civil law, as well as housing and employment related matters. In this respect,

advocacy has become one of the core elements in response to violence against women, enabling women to access their rights across multiple systems. This form of coordination on a specific case has received far less attention than coordination between professionals at high-level meetings, but several research studies have shown that key lessons are learnt when a single worker navigates the system, highlighting the small, but nonetheless significant, barriers and blockages that hamper effective responses.

The international literature focuses far more on forms of coordination that take place at highlevel meetings between representatives of agencies representing different sectors, and/or well-funded inter-agency demonstration projects. Whilst some of these examples have had remarkable effects, this is partly the outcome of pre-existing good practice in participating agencies and local efforts, coupled with commitment and political will to work in coalition with others and to address any problems or conflicts that emerge. Too often inter-agency work at local levels is little more than ‘window-dressing’ meetings, roundtables and even entire projects which result in reports, workshops or conferences, but create minimal change in the support, safety and services provided for victims/survivors, the sanctions applied to perpetrators or the efforts aimed at prevention. A clear leadership role for women’s specialist services should be built into all inter-agency projects alongside a linked reference group of survivors, or another feedback mechanism, to ensure accountability and monitoring.

As seen above ‘experts’ throughout the UN (and other NGOs) are correct in their assessment of what SHOULD BE done. However, they are CONSISTENTLY negligent in implementing their rhetoric into concrete ACTION.

One of the fundamental problems plaguing economies (and societies) around the world finds its roots in western feminist movement. This movement was started by Betty Friedan with publication of her book, *The Feminine Mystique*, in 1963. However, feminists like Gloria Steinem and Eleanor Smeal high-jacked the movement, and why in 1981 Friedan published another book, *The Second Stage*. In this book she admonished the alpha-dominance feminists for having been responsible for promoting and encouraging the bullying traditions of abusive and manipulative women—instead of challenging the dysfunctional and abusive alpha-dominance traditions of men. Phyliss Chelser in her book, *Woman’s Inhumanity to Woman*, goes into further detail regarding women on women abuse in society—exposing the elevated level of bullying by women. My research and activism work of the past 10 years builds on Betty Friedan’s (and Riane Eisler) in challenging the dysfunctional western feminist movement and the enormous problems it has created for women and children in society, as explained in my reports... and presentation at the Battered Mother’s Custody Conference, 2015.

Unfortunately, the American alpha-dominance feminist movement, which has since been exported to countries around the world, has only served to re-inforce the abuses of power (including violence against women) which have dominated societies for thousands of years. This is why sexual harassment, bullying, and other abuses of power in workplaces, and the problems it is creating, have only increased in past decades—along with the traditions and customs which are covering-up for these abuses of power. The UN report *Indepth Study on All Forms of Violence Against Women (VAW)* explains not only how VAW is a human rights issue, but also how it is women in societies who perpetuate the norms and customs of VAW, as well as its cover-up (see endnote^v).

One of the great problems

As I explain in my correspondence to Prince Charles (Petition to the British Crown) historical figures in my family tree have been challenging the dysfunctional alpha-dominance paradigm for over 500 years—starting with the Puritan movement in England with Thomas Wilcox’s publication of ‘Admonitions to Parliament’ (aka The Puritan Manifesto, 1572) which challenged the expansionism of Elizabeth I and abuses of power within the Church of England. It also includes John Dickinson (Penman of the Revolution) and John Paul Jones (Father of the American Navy) during the American Revolution, Winston Churchill during WWII, my grand-father and the Old Jim Crow, and my father who has been challenging the predatory American health-care system and medical community his entire career.

^w *As women sought to gain equality and recognition of their rights in many areas, they drew attention to the fact that violence against women was not the result of random, individual acts of misconduct, but was deeply rooted in structural relationships of inequality between women and men (see sect. III). In calling for action and redress for these violations nationally and internationally, women exposed the role of violence against women as a form of discrimination and a mechanism to perpetuate it. This process led to the identification of many different forms and manifestations of violence against women (see sect. IV), drawing them out of the private domain to public attention and the arena of State accountability.....*

Studies on violence against women have been carried out by a wide variety of bodies, including government ministries, national statistical offices, universities, international agencies, NGOs and women's rights organizations. The results have provided compelling evidence that violence against women is a severe and pervasive human rights violation throughout the world, with devastating effects on the health and well-being of women and children...

The implementation of international norms and standards on violence against women requires comprehensive legal, policy and other measures at the national level, with the involvement of many stakeholders. These include all levels of the State at federal, state, provincial and local levels, as well as all branches of Government, including the judiciary, legislature and executive. Collaboration and coordination between all stakeholders, including Governments, NGOs and civil society organizations are vital for an effective approach to redressing such violence ...

Violence prevents women from contributing to, and benefiting from, development by restricting their choices and limiting their ability to act. The resulting consequences for economic growth and poverty reduction should be of central concern to Governments. Violence against women also undermines and constrains the achievement of the Millennium Development Goals, including those set in the areas of poverty, education, child health, maternal mortality, HIV/AIDS and overall sustainable development. Unless attention to preventing and redressing violence against women is incorporated in programmes to realize each of the Millennium Development Goals, the health, social and economic consequences of such violence can limit the potential benefits of these initiatives. Ultimately, the persistence of violence against women is inconsistent with all the Millennium Development Goals....

*Since many existing social controls already rationalize or endorse various forms of violence against women, the social changes triggered by globalization in many contexts have tended to produce new forms or worsened existing forms of violence against women, including trafficking on a global scale.... The large-scale inequities and upheavals associated with globalization exacerbate the conditions that generate violence against women by amplifying disparities of wealth and social privilege and impoverishing rural economies. They can also **expose women to violence in the form of exploitative working conditions in inadequately regulated industries***

Violence against women has far-reaching consequences for women, their children and community and society as a whole. Women who experience violence suffer a range of health

problems and their ability to earn a living and to participate in public life is diminished. Their children are significantly more at risk for health problems, poor school performance and behavioural disturbances... The costs of violence against women, apart from the human costs, go beyond lowered economic production and reduced human capital formation but also include the costs associated with political and social instability through intergenerational transmission of violence, as well as the funds required for programmes for victims/survivors of violence...

While women commit a small proportion of intimate partner violence, they are involved to a greater degree in the perpetration of harmful traditional practices and in trafficking....

Culture is formed by the values, practices and power relations that are interwoven into the daily lives of individuals and their communities. Social behaviour is mediated by culture in all societies and culture affects most manifestations of violence everywhere.... Women are also actors in constituting culture: they “influence and build the cultures around them, changing them as they resist, and reinforcing and recreating them as they conform” ... Key aspects of women’s individual identities are interwoven with their cultural communities and their participation in cultural customs and practices. Women not only suffer from negative aspects of the cultures in which they live, they also benefit from and are supported by positive cultural values and practices within their communities....

Women also face pervasive violence within the general community. Physical, sexual and psychological violence can be a daily feature of women’s interactions in their neighbourhoods, on public transport, in workplaces, schools, sports clubs, colleges and hospitals, and in religious and other social institutions.... There are several types of costs, in the short and long term: first, the direct cost of services in relation to violence against women; second, the indirect cost of lost employment and productivity; and third, the value placed on human pain and suffering.

Impunity for violence against women compounds the effects of such violence as a mechanism of control. When the State fails to hold the perpetrators accountable, impunity not only intensifies the subordination and powerlessness of the targets of violence, but also sends a message to society that [] violence against women is both acceptable and inevitable. As a result, patterns of violent behaviour are normalized.
